Personnel beyond the normal company complement are charged at hourly rates. Incident response fees include but are not limited to, Mitigation of Hazardous Materials, False Alarms due to “Failure to Notify” when working on or testing system, Trouble Alarms due to “Failure to Notify” when working on or testing system, 3 or more false alarms within the calendar year.</p>
